### **Purpose and legal basis for the processing of personal data**

The Safety Investigation Authority provides information on ongoing and completed safety investigations in accordance with Section 38 of the Safety Investigation Act of Finland (525/2011).

To implement effective communication, the Safety Investigation Authority maintains electronic mailing lists of media representatives and cooperation partners in public administration and the private sector.

The communication-related processing of personal data is necessary for the performance of tasks carried out in the public interest and for the exercise of official

authority. The legal basis for processing is Article 6(1)(e) of the General Data Protection Regulation, Section 4(2) of the Finnish Data Protection Act (1050/2018), as well as Section 20 of the Act on the Openness of Government Activities (621/1999).

### **Description of the group of data subjects and the categories of personal data being processed**

The group of data subjects consists of media representatives and other cooperation partners.

Personal data processed mainly include the name and contact details of the person, such as their email address. In addition, information on the person's position, organisation and sector can be processed.

### **Regular sources of personal data**

Personal data is mainly obtained from the data subject.

### **Personal data recipients**

Personal data is disclosed to the Government ICT Centre Valtori, which, with its subcontractors, produces IT services for the Safety Investigation Authority. Service providers process personal data on behalf of the Safety Investigation Authority and may not process the data for purposes other than the provision of the agreed service.

Disclosure of data to other parties is assessed in accordance with the Act on the Openness of Government Activities (621/1999).

The data will not be disclosed for direct marketing and opinion polling or market research, unless the disclosure of data for this purpose is separately provided for by law.

## **Information on transfers of personal data outside the EU/EEA or to an international organisation**

Personal data is not transferred outside the European Union or the European Economic Area or to international organisations.

## **Data retention periods**

Personal data is stored for a period necessary for stakeholder communications. The data is updated in accordance with the notifications of persons or organisations participating in stakeholder cooperation.

## **Technical and organisational security measures**

Personal data processed in information systems and otherwise digitally is protected against unauthorised viewing, alteration and erasure. The protection of data processed in information systems is based on access rights management, technical security of databases and servers, physical security of facilities, access control, communication security and data backup. Access rights and right to process data are granted on the basis of work tasks, and access to the authorities' information systems is always based on personal user IDs.

Staff are provided with instructions and training on the appropriate protection and erasure of personal data processed in the course of their duties.
